VSPM DCRC established in year 1996 , initially had an intake of 60 students and later increased to 100 from 2002 onwards . PG courses started from the year 2007.

All different stream teachers are taking weekly rounds of hostel and mess and submitting their reports.

Centralized mess has started from this year. Mess food quality and hygiene is monitored by these teachers during their rounds. Mess menu is prepared in consultation with student representatives and staff. Highest quality of food and strict hygiene standards are maintained.

All hostels are equipped with solar water geysers, RO Drinking water, water cooler, gas cylinder, visitor's room and reading room.

Total four meetings were held in this year. Civil Department is currently working on seepage issue in all the hostels and connecting roads to all hostels.

The committee meets biannually at the beginning of the terms that is in May-June and Dec-Jan. to prepare the schedule of theory classes and practical/clinical postings for the student. Meetings are also conducted as and when required. The following guidelines provided by MUHS Nashik and DCI need to be considered at the time of preparation of the time table.

In addition to the above, the committee also supervises the MUHS Nashik theory exams and practical exams with regards to appointment of Centre In charge, Centre Observer, Internal Vigilance Officer and Central Assessment Programme (CAP) for theory papers of university exam. The availability of university exams external examiners and if need arises appointment of substitute external examiner is co-ordinated with the internal examiner and MUHS, Nashik.

After the completion of internal assessment examination the complete information of marks obtained in theory and practical exams is submitted to the university. Also the verification of marks with theory and practical exam papers done by the centre observer at the time of university theory exam is co-ordinated with the respective departments.

The research protocol should be submitted in the prescribed format of the IEC in triplicate along with the suggested enclosures till the 7th of every month. IEC meetings are scheduled once monthly, including 2 meetings for approval of synopsis of final dissertation of first year PG students. Synopsis presentation of dissertation topics of PhD scholars also carried out before the submission to MUHS University, Nashik. Subject experts are invited to enrich and validate the research protocol whenever required. According to committee decision, all research projects in the institution are undertaken only after written approval from the IEC. It is mandatory that all research projects by staff, PhD scholars, PG, UG students and interns should be approved by the IEC.

The principal investigator of the research project has to give brief audio-visual presentation of the research project. Certificate of the approval of the research project is issued to the principal investigator. The ongoing research projects are reviewed at regular intervals. The principal investigator has to provide a justification if the research project is not completed in the time period mentioned in the synopsis. All research documents are preserved for a minimum of three years after completion of the study. A completed report of the research project has to be submitted to the IEC of all completed research projects in the departments.

Department of Oral Medicine and Radiology

Brief profile

The Department of Oral Medicine and Radiology deals with the diagnosis and non-surgical management of Oro- facial diseases and the oral manifestations of systemic disorders, as well as with the maxillofacial imaging. Theory lectures and practical postings are conducted for the III and IV BDS students. Post graduation started in the subject from 2009 with the intake capacity of 3 students per year. Oral radiology is well equipped with the conventional as well as advanced imaging facilities utilized for the Under-graduate as well as Post Graduate students. Department of Oral Medicine and Radiology, VSPM'S Dental College and Research Centre, Nagpur, organized a full day Workshop on topic "CBCT Hands-on - Workshop "Cone Beam CT Interpretation "dated 13th January, guest lecture on 3-D printing in Dentistry by Dr. Patait & 2018 and CDE on Management of difficult patient dated 21/12/18.

Latest development in year 2018- To initiate Tobacco Cessation Centre counselling centre as per the DCI guidelines for which a lecture was conducted in December by eminent speaker Dr Sushil Gawande, Associate Professor MD Psychiatry on topic on Management of Difficult Patient.

Also small group teaching discussion exercise for final years was conducted by staff. Along with this a separate case based group discussions also initiated for Post-Graduate students on Cone Beam Computed tomography & Computed Tomography images to upgrade their knowledge.
