Clinical Implications of TMJ Disorders- Enhancing Skills of Undergraduates

About the course: Learning TMJ examination and disorders is an integral part of undergraduate curriculum. Although TMJ anatomy and diseases are taught via didactic lectures in final year BDS, a thorough understanding of TMJ pathologies with clinical implications was thought to be needed. Hence this 'Add on Course' was designed for final year undergraduates by the department to develop better clinicians.

Objectives: To teach TMJ pathologies in detail and train students for accurate diagnosis and management of TMJ pathologies during undergraduate years.

Participant eligibility: Passed III year BDS

Course duration: 6 months

Tentative month: Summer & Winter Batch (first month of joining)

Schedule: In session I first Pre Test will be conducted. Day two will consist of Lectures on Anatomy of TMJ in health and disease followed by group activity. Part three of session will deal with Classification of TMJ disorders and various etiologic factors of disorders and will be followed by group activity. Session

II will be dedicated to Panel discussion and Post-test.

Students are evaluated for two TMJ cases individually during clinical posting in the Department of Oral Medicine & Radiology, at Ranjeet Deshmukh Dental College and Research Centre, Nagpur.
